Coil Construction receives awards honoring design, craftsmanship and safety

COLUMBIA, MO. (Sept.13, 2007) — Coil Construction, Inc., was recently honored with two awards, one recognizing its design and craftsmanship abilities as the general contractor for The Broadway Shops in Columbia and the other for the company's outstanding overall safety record.

The commercial construction firm in Columbia received a 2007 VP Buildings Best in Category award for its work on The Broadway Shops, a nearly 86,000-square-foot retail shopping center in east Columbia. The awards competition recognizes excellence in design, craftsmanship and construction and is sponsored by Varco-Pruden, a supplier of pre-fabricated buildings. Varco-Pruden, based in Memphis, TN, holds the contest annually for companies that have been designated as Varco-Pruden authorized builders. Coil Construction received one of five awards given in the retail category in 2007.

The Broadway Shops, located at 2703 E. Broadway, was designed to create an upscale feel through the use of brick, cast stone and other features that enhance the building's architecture. The two-story buildings include various tower elements that frame the rest of the structure to create the look of a series of downtown buildings. It was designed by the architectural firm of Berger Devine Yaeger in Kansas City, MO. Jim

Holman, engineering manager for Coil Construction, served as the project manager for the \$5 million building project that was completed in May 2005.

In a second award received in July, Coil Construction was recognized by the Builders' Association Self-Insurers' Fund for excellence in the safety aspect of its construction business. The award, handed out six to 10 times during the year to Builders' Association Self-Insurers' Fund members, recognizes excellence in field safety, claims management and loss prevention. The Builders' Association Self-Insurers' Fund, based in Kansas City, MO., is a provider of workers' compensation coverage for more than 400 commercial contractors in Missouri and Kansas.
