Coil Construction project featured in *Modern Builder* publication

COLUMBIA, MO. (Aug. 2, 2007) — Coil Construction, Inc., a Columbia-based commercial construction firm, recently was featured in the cover article of *Modern Builder* magazine for its work on a new student center on the Central Methodist University campus in Fayette, Mo.

Published in the July/August 2007 issue of *Modern Builder*, the article detailed the \$15 million building project that was completed in 2005 after two years of construction. The new 60,000-square-foot Student and Community Center on the edge of the university's quadrangle is distinguished by a skylight-capped atrium and circular staircase that span three of the building's four stories.
